Opinion of the Court. will prosecute his appeal to effect, and without unnecessary delay second, that if judgment be rendered against him on the appeal, he will satisfy such judgment and costs. Such undertaking need not be signed by the appellant (Gen. Stat. 800.) SEC. 122. The appeal shall be complete upon filing and approval of the undertaking as provided in section 121. The said justice shall immediately make out a certified transcript of his proceedings in the cause, and shall, within twenty days from the rendition of the judgment, deliver or transmit to the clerk of the district court of the county the said transcript, the undertaking on appeal, and all the papers in the cause. All farther proceedings before the justice of the peace in the case shall cease and be stayed on the filing of the undertaking with said justice. No notice of appeal shall be required to be filed or served and the case shall be tried de novo in the district court upon the original papers on which the cause was tried before the justice, unless the appellate court, in furtherance of justice, allow amended pleadings to be made, or new pleadings to be filed. (Laws of 1870, p. 184, 7, amending 122 of the justices act.) Before proceeding further we would say, that there is nothing to be found in any statute that in terms repeals or modifies any of the provisions of said section 30 of the act relating to counties and county officers. And the act of 1874, relating to roads and highways, does not contain that general clause, often found in statutes, repealing all acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith. The only question then is, simply, whether said section 7 of the act relating to roads and highways, does, of itself, and solely by implication, so repeal said sec...
