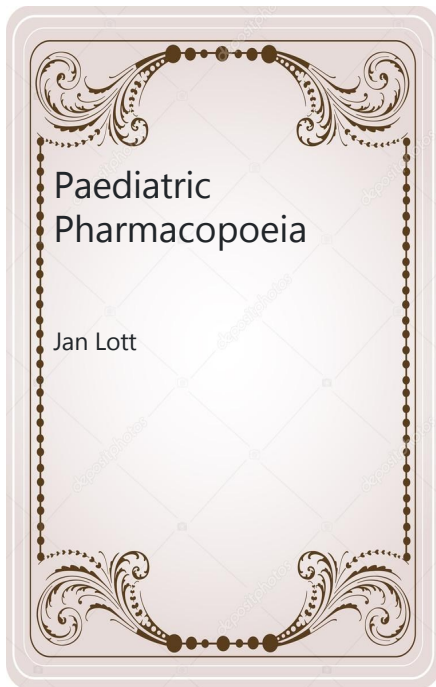


# Paediatric Pharmacopoeia
